WATER USE RESTRICTION AREA

An aquatic herbicide application is planned for areas of Cocolalla Lake between Monday August 6th and Friday August 10th, 2012. Renovate, a liquid triclopyr (EPA Registration # 62719-37-67690) will be applied to treat Eurasian watermilfoil growth.

Water Use restrictions will be in effect for households utilizing water from the lake that are located up to ½ mile of treated areas, as follows:

- **Potable water:** Functioning potable water intakes must be turned off until the triclopyr level in the intake water is determined to be 0.4 parts per million (ppm) or less by laboratory analysis or immunoassay.
- Irrigation: Treated water may be used for irrigation once the triclopyr level in the intake water is determined to be non-detectable by laboratory analysis (immunoassay). There is no restriction on use of water from the treatment area to irrigate established grasses.
- Recreational Use of Water in treatment Area: There are no restrictions on use of water in the treatment area for recreational purposes, including swimming and fishing.
- Livestock Use of Water from treatment Area: There are no restrictions on livestock consumption of water from the treatment area.

Home owners near treatment areas who use water from the lake for drinking or irrigation are advised to not use lake water until herbicide residue samples indicate that levels in the water are within acceptable use levels specified by the herbicide label.
